Rent and Utility Bill Assistance Available for Consumers through SC Stay Plus Program: To help South Carolinians whose ability to pay rent and/or utility bills is diminished due to COVID-19, SC Housing is administering the SC Stay Plus program

Eligible renters can receive assistance with:

- 12 months of back rent (arrears) dating back to March 2020
- Up to (3) additional months of future rental assistance for those at risk of homelessness or housing instability (eviction)
- Utility assistance paid directly to the utility companies for past-due electric, natural
 gas, water, or wastewater bills dating back to March 2020. To apply for assistance
